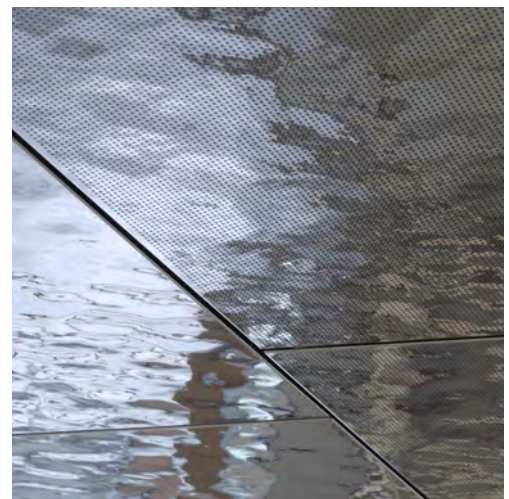
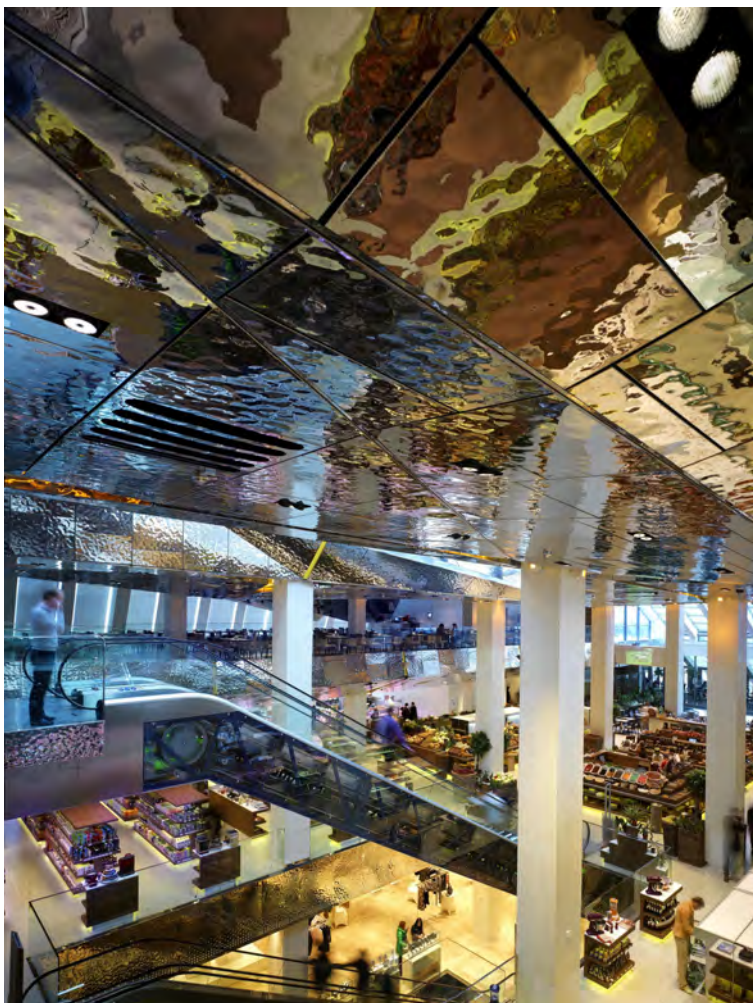


High-gloss ceiling panels

Tsvetnoy Central Market is located on the prestigious Tsvetnoy Boulevard in the centre of Moscow. The top three floors of this luxury department store are taken up by a food hall with integrated restaurant area and rooftop café. The ceilings and walls are clad with stainless steel sheet (EN 1.4301) formed to produce a three-dimensional finish resembling the surface of water ruffled by a breeze. Kaleidoscopic reflections of sales counters, goods and shoppers bounce off these mechanically polished panels in a spectacular interior design concept that fulfils not only aesthetic requirements but also acoustic functions. Some of the panels were perforated before forming, and lined with acoustic fleece.



Perforated stainless steel panels help to absorb noise and add to the quality feel in this high-end store.



Some of the stainless steel panels on the ceiling are perforated with a 16 % open area and backed with acoustic fleece.
